a. Cathy McNeil and Kelly Howard from YG Home Care explained they are conducting a review of the Home Care program and are interested in inviting input from Mt. Lorne residents as well as other communities. They are seeking council's suggestions for:

The review will take place over the next few months. Council suggested they:

b. Carolyn Moore, Community Advisory

1. Carolyn summarized the work to date on the Cemetery Project. The site originally identified is zoned as 'hinterland' and would require a zoning change or amendment. Other possible sites could be identified which comply with the zoning. Al confirmed that LMCA's preference remains the original site. Carolyn explained that the most streamlined process would be for the government to reserve the land and then make it available as a lease to the LMCA.

MOTION 2017-11-002: Bill moved that LAC recommend to Community Affairs that they reserve the site for the cemetery and initiate the required procedure. Ann second - CARRIED

Carolyn will advise whether we can use the government mail out to consult residents regarding use of a public water supply.
